

ADDENDUM TO BOP GUIDANCE ON CONDUCTING ANNUAL FIREARMS TRAINING DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

While attempting to allow staff who may be at higher risk of complication during this pandemic to participate in annual firearms qualification, the following additional guidance must be incorporated for use at the range during training for individuals who are working with an approved COVID-19 TJM.

- All aspects of the original fire arms guidance remains in effect, the only modification are as follows.
- Reduce the number of participant by half, to allow for greater social distancing
- Each participant will wear a face covering anytime they are not on the firing line, regardless of capability to adhere to social distancing guidance.

Example of participant reduction, if the institution has 25 firing positions and utilized every other firing position during this years AT firearms qualification which allowed for 13 participants, the reduced number for participants on a TJM is 7. This doubles the allowance of space for social distancing.

As before all briefings must be conducted outdoors with appropriate social distancing and facial covering as appropriate.
