COVID -19 VISITING PROCEDURES

MDC Brooklyn will resume social visiting on Monday, April 26, 2021. The following Visiting schedule and procedures have been modified in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Please review and familiarize yourself with the revised schedule and procedures for the visiting institution **prior to your arrival** to expedite the screening process in the Front Lobby and / or screening site. Please arrive 30 minutes before your visit. Review the attached schedule for revised days of the week, hours, and length of visitation.

The frequency and number of visitors have been adjusted and scheduled to allow inmates to only visit on the respective day assigned to their housing unit. In order to avoid potential exposure and the spread of the virus, housing units will have designated days where they will receive social visits. (Attachment A). This will allow inmates the opportunity to visit at least once a month.

Social visiting is conducted by the housing unit. Social visiting will take place from Monday to Friday from 12:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m. The restarting of social visits will not affect legal visits, which takes place Monday to Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Visitors must arrive 30 minutes prior to their visit.

Due to the need for social distancing and space limitations within the visiting room, social visits will not exceed one hour in length.

NOTE:

There will be no legal or social visiting after 4:00 p.m., on October 8, 2021 and October 11, 2021.

COVID -19 VISITING PROCEDURES

All visitors are required to wear a mask or face covering **prior** to entering the Front Lobby or screening site and at all times while on institution property. The mask or face covering must cover the nose and mouth.

- Total number of inmates allowed in the visiting room: 8
 Inmates will only be authorized one (1) visitor per social visit.
 - All visitors must be on the approved list to include pretrial and holdover inmates.
- The mask or face covering should be plain and cannot be bandana material or style.
- Visitation is non-contact. Physical contact is strictly prohibited at all times. There will be no embrace or kiss at the beginning or end of the visit.
- Any violation of the non-contact protocols may result in the visit being terminated.

All visitors will undergo a simple symptom screening and temperature check prior to being allowed to enter the institution.

Visitors experiencing any of the following symptoms will not be allowed to enter the institution:

- Temperature >100 degrees
- · New On-Set Cough
- New On-Set Trouble in Speaking / Difficulty Breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or Body Aches
- Sore Throat
- New lost Taste or Smell
- Stuffy/Runny Nose
- Nausea or Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- The children's play area will be closed.
- · Vending machines will be closed.
