

MODIFIED COVID-19 SOCIAL VISITATION

FCI Cumberland will begin a modified social visiting schedule for the inmate population on Saturday, October 3, 2020. The following procedures will be implemented to comply with social distancing requirements.

FCI Visiting Hours- Saturday and Sunday 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

The Visiting Schedule will be as follows:

A Unit – First weekend of the month starting with Saturday (10/3/20)

B Unit – Second weekend of the month

C Unit – Third weekend of the month

D Unit – Fourth weekend of the month

CAMP Visiting Hours- Saturday and Sunday 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

The Visiting Schedule will be as follows:

G Unit – First weekend of the month starting with Saturday (10/3/2020) and third weekend of the month

P Unit – Second and fourth weekends of the month

- **Immediate family members only.** Immediate Family is considered: Mother, Father, Step-Parents, Foster Parents, Brothers, Sisters, Spouse, Children (A child who is under the age of 16 must have a parent or guardian present)
***NOTE:** Exceptions may be made to allow one non-immediate family member guardian that is on the inmate's approved visiting list to accompany visiting children 16 and under.
- Both visitors and inmates must wear face coverings at all times
- The number of visitors allowed in either visiting room will be limited to 3 visitors per inmate at one time.
- No physical contact of any kind will be allowed between the visitor and the inmate. This includes: hugs, embraces, hand holding, or touching of any kind.
- Inmates and their visitors will not be authorized to take photographs based on the inability to socially distance themselves.
- There will be no food or beverages allowed in the Visiting Rooms, with the exception of baby formula for an infant visiting child.
- There are visitation stations set up in the Visiting Rooms spaced six feet apart.
- Inmates and visitors will not be allowed to move from his or her station, with the exception of using the rest room.
- Neither the inmate nor visitor will be allowed to move his or her chair or table from the authorized marked visiting station.
- Violating any of these procedures will result in termination of the visit.
- Visits may be limited to prevent overcrowding.

In the event of an issue requiring a change to the visiting schedule, the FCI Cumberland BOP public website and institutional telephone greeting will be updated with the changes for visitors.

This schedule may be adjusted in the future to reduce or increase the amount of visits or visitors after evaluating the initial implementation. Family members may refer to this BOP public website for further visiting information.
