# Temporary Visiting Regulations

DATE: October 2, 2020  
SUBJECT: Visiting Regulations

FCI Elkton will resume social visiting on Saturday, October 3, 2020. The following procedures and procedures will be followed, with no exceptions.

To allow for social distancing and safe visiting, the following guidelines have been implemented:

- All visits are by appointment only and will be initiated by the inmate. Time and date of the requested visit will be determined by unit team based on space availability. Three 1-hour visiting blocks will be available Sundays-Wednesdays and Saturdays, as follows:
  - o Block 1 - 9:00 a.m. - 10:00 a.m.
  - o Block 2 - 11:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.
  - o Block 3 - 2:00 p.m. - 3:00 p.m.
- Visitors will be limited to two adults, immediate family only. Per Program Statement 5267.09, Visiting Regulations, immediate family is defined as mother, father, step-parents, foster parents, brothers, sisters, spouse, and children. No children under the age of 18 will be allowed to visit at this time. All visitors must be on your approved visiting list.
- Inmates and visitors will be required to wear a face covering at all times during the visit. Visitor face coverings must meet CDC guidelines, must be solid in color, and will be approved prior to entrance in the institution. Face coverings will not be provided to visitors.
- There will be no contact between inmates and visitors. Any contact will terminate the visit immediately.
- Only approved visitors will be allowed on institution property.
- All visitors will have a temperature and symptom screening prior to entering institution property. If either party in the vehicle fails to meet the temperature and/or symptom screening, the visit will be canceled.

- Visits will be limited to 1-hour only. This will allow for sanitizing between visiting groups.
- There will be no food or drinks allowed in the visiting room. Vending machines will not be available.
- For social distancing and processing purposes, visitors will have a specific arrival time. If they miss their scheduled arrival time, the visit will be canceled. It is the inmate's responsibility to notify approved visitors of their arrival time.
