MEMORANDUM FOR: INMATE VISITATION

SUBJECT: Social Visitation during COVID-19.

Effective Saturday, October 3, 2020, FCC Hazelton will resume social visits. The following visitation protocols and guidelines will be enforced at FCC Hazelton.

General Visitation Information:

- Visits will be non-contact only.
- All inmates and visitors will remain 6 feet apart to abide by social distancing guidelines.
- Visits will be 45 minutes in length to allow for enhanced sanitation in between visiting groups.
- Only 3 visitors, of any age, will be allowed per inmate.
- Inmates in quarantine, holdover, or isolation status will not be permitted to participate.
- Visitation will be held on Saturdays and Sundays only. Inmates are allowed (1) visit a day which will be held during their housing unit's allotted time.
- If adverse weather and/or an institutional emergency occurs during your allotted time, your visit may be cancelled.
- Inmates will schedule visiting appointments with their unit team.
- **If you do not have a scheduled appointment, you will not be able to visit.**
- Appointment times will be strictly followed.

Personal Protective Equipment:

- Inmates and visitors will wear a face covering at all times. There will be a zero tolerance policy on face coverings. Your visit will be terminated if the face covering is removed at any time inside the Visitation Room.
- Specifically face coverings will cover an individual's mouth and nose and allow the individual to remain hands-free. They will fit snugly against the side of the face and be secured with ties or ear loops.
- Any child older than 2 years of age is required to wear a face covering.
- If for medical reasons a face covering cannot be worn, it is permitted to wear a face shield which is secured behind the head and also covers both the nose and mouth.
- Bandannas are not an approved face covering.

Additional Information:

- Visitors will be temperature screened at the entrance of FCC Hazelton. Any symptomatic visitors will be denied entry at this time.
- At the screening site, visitors will obtain a Notification to Visitor form (BP-A0224) and a COVID-19 screening tool which will need to be filled out in their vehicles before entering the Front Lobby area.
- There will be a physical barrier between inmates and visitors inside of the Visitation Room. Please do not touch this barrier.
- There will be no photos, food or drink, permitted inside of the Visitation Room.

As COVID-19 is an evolving situation presented to the Bureau of Prisons, these guidelines are subject to change at any time.
