Phase Nine Social Visiting Plan

This memorandum is to identify the phase nine social visiting plan for USP Marion. Effective Saturday, October 3, 2020, USP Marion will resume social visitation. USP visitation will be held on Friday, Saturday and Sunday between the hours of 7:30 AM to 3:00 PM. Camp visitation will be held on Saturday and Sunday between the hours of 7:30 AM to 3:00 PM.

All visitors will be temperature and symptom checked at the front entrance using the current screening tool. Visitors will be processed on a first come, first serve basis and will adhere to social distancing requirements in the front lobby. If social distancing requirements cannot be met, visitors will be asked to wait outside for systematic processing. Social visitation will not be provided to inmates in quarantine and isolation units.

The visiting areas at the USP and Camp have been redesigned to maximize social distancing, with a minimum of six feet in between persons. The USP capacity is 16 inmates and 32 visitors, while the Camp capacity is 22 inmates and 44 visitors. Visitation time slots are scheduled for one unit at a time to avoid the mixing of cohorts. All staff will be wearing proper PPE while processing, escorting and monitoring the visiting room. Schedule and procedures will be adjusted as needed. See attached procedures for the USP and Camp.
