

USP Visitation Procedures

- Visitation will be Friday, Saturday and Sunday
- Limit of 2 visitors per inmate/per visit (lap held infants, 12 months or less, will not be counted as a visitor)
 - Visitation time will be limited to one hour per visit
 - Visitation will be based on first come, first serve basis
- Visitation will be non-contact only to include embraces and touching in any way
 - No photographs are permitted
- Minimum of 6-feet between all visitors and inmates will be maintained
 - Visitors will be screened and temperature checked upon entry
 - Sick or symptomatic visitors will not be permitted entry
- Inmates and visitors must wear an approved face covering at all times
- Inmates and visitors must perform hand hygiene before and after visit
- No food or drink will be permitted (provisions for baby food/formula will be made)
 - Enhanced sanitation will be conducted at the conclusion of all visits
 - Inmates in Isolation and Quarantine will not be permitted to visit
- Frequency of visits will be adjusted to ensure all inmates have an opportunity to visit
 - Schedule and procedures will be adjusted as needed

Inmates are permitted two visitors per visit. To ensure equal opportunities, frequency of visits determines any termination. Appropriate face coverings are mandatory for all inmates and visitors. Face coverings will be secured and issued to visitors who arrive without a proper face covering. No physical contact between visitors and inmates is permitted. Photographs, vending machines, water fountains and the children’s play area are prohibited from use. Alcohol based hand sanitizer is available in the front lobby as well as the entrance and exit points in the visiting room. Orderlies are assigned to each visitation room and will continually sanitize all surfaces in the visitation area.

Camp Visitation Procedures

- Visitation will be Saturday and Sunday
- Limit of 2 visitors per inmate/per visit (lap held infants, 12 months or less, will not be counted as a visitor)
- Visitation time will be limited either AM or PM visits
- Visitation will be based by Inmate Last Name A - K and L - Z
- Visitation hours will rotate each day Mornings one day and afternoons the next
- Visitation will be non-contact only
- Visitation will be closed from 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. for cleaning
- No physical contact (including embraces) or photographs are permitted
- Minimum of 6-feet between all visitors and inmates will be maintained
- Visitors will be screened and temperature checked upon entry
- Sick or symptomatic visitors will not be permitted entry
- Inmates and visitors must wear an approved face covering at all times
- Inmates and visitors must perform hand hygiene before and after visit
- No food or drink will be permitted (provisions for baby food/formula)
- Enhanced sanitation will be conducted at the conclusion of all visits
- Inmates in Isolation and Quarantine will not be permitted to visit
- Frequency of visits will be adjusted to ensure all inmates have an opportunity to visit
- Schedule and procedures will be adjusted as needed
