

FCI Mendota Modified Social Visiting Guidelines

Social Visiting will resume Thursday, October 1, 2020, under the following conditions:

- Visitation will be non-contact only. Due to the new visiting capacity restrictions, the length of time afforded to individual inmate visits may be reduced dependent upon the number of inmates receiving visits on a particular day.
- For the safety of staff, inmates and the public, inmates who are on Quarantine or Isolation status will not be afforded visitation. All visitors will undergo a symptom screening and temperature check upon entry into the facility. Visitors who are sick or symptomatic will not be allowed to visit.
- Both inmates and visitors must wear facial coverings at all times and perform hand hygiene prior to and at the conclusion of the visit. Inappropriate facial covering (e.g. bandanas, those with insignias) will not be permitted into the institution.
- Being that all visits are non-contact, embracing at the beginning and end of a visit will not be permitted. Additionally, inmates and their visitors will not be authorized to take photographs based on the inability to maintain appropriate social distance.
- Food and beverages will not be allowed for consumption or purchase. Accommodations will be provided for infant children by storing formula/food on the staff desk and can be requested as needed for feeding of the infant.
- Failure to follow these COVID-19 visitation guidelines will result in immediate termination of the visit.

CAMP VISITATION

Appropriate social distancing will be enforced and marked by the use of tape to assist in mitigating the spread of COVID-19. Due to space limitations there will be no more than nine (9) inmates and no more than three (3) visitors per inmate allowed admittance into the Visiting Room at a time.

FCI VISITATION

Plexiglas dividers will be utilized to maintain social distancing and assist in mitigating the spread of COVID-19. Due to limitations on available space, there will be no more than eleven (11) inmates and no more than three (3) visitors per inmate allowed admittance into the Visiting Room at a time.
