

**FCC YAZOO CITY / USP Institution**  
**COVID-19 SOCIAL VISITING PROCEDURES**

- Visitation is by appointment only.
  - Inmates must submit a visitation request form to their counselor.
  - Visitation requests will be honored based on the space availability needed to maintain social distancing.
- A maximum of two (2) visitors are allowed per inmate.
  - Children of any age count as a visitor.
- All visitors must wear a plain, non-vented, cloth face mask that covers the mouth and nose at all times.
- Upon arrival, all visitors will be directed to the COVID-19 medical screening site.
- All visitors will complete a medical screening form and a temperature check.
- Visitors who are sick or symptomatic will not be allowed to visit.
- Visitors permitted to proceed to visitation will be given a medical pass.
- Visitors will proceed to their designated institution and show their medical pass.
- Visitors will fill out a BP-A0224 (June 10) "Notification to Visitors" form.
  - The visitor will write their cellular phone number at the top of the form.
- All visitors will return to their vehicle.
  - The visitor will be called on the phone number provided when they can enter the institution and begin processing for visitation.
- All visitors must wash their hands and use the provided hand sanitizer when entering the institution and again before exiting the visiting room.
- **ALL VISITATION WILL BE NON-CONTACT ONLY.**
  - Socially acceptable gestures of communication and affection, such as shaking hands, kissing and embracing, are **strictly prohibited**.
  - Photographs will not be available.
- Inmates and visitors will sit six (6) feet apart for required distancing and utilize a required mask.
- If visitors need to use the bathroom they can request individual use to avoid crowding in that area.
- In order to stop the spread of germs, microwaves, vending machines, and water fountains will be

inaccessible.

- o All currency is unauthorized.
- o Bottled water will be available if needed.
- Authorized child-care items:
  - o One (1) clear baby bottle (no glass).
  - o One (1) unopened container of baby food.
  - o One (1) baby spoon.
  - o One (1) diaper.
  - o One (1) small container of wipes.
  - o One (1) clear, transparent bag to store the items in.
