SOCIAL VISITING PROCEDURES

- **FCI Low Visitation is Monday through Wednesday, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.**
- **Visitation is by appointment only.**
- Inmates must submit a visitation request to their counselor.
- Visitation requests will be honored based on the space availability needed to maintain social distancing.
 - A maximum of five (5) visitors are allowed per inmate.
 - Children of any age count as a visitor.
- All visitors must wear a plain, non-vented, face mask that covers the mouth and nose at all times.
- Visitors who are sick or symptomatic will not be allowed to visit.
- Visitors will fill out a BP-A0224 “Notification to Visitors” form.

ALL VISITATION WILL BE NON-CONTACT ONLY.

- Socially acceptable gestures of communication and affection, such as shaking hands, kissing and embracing, are strictly **prohibited**.
- Photographs will not be available.
- Inmates and visitors will sit six (6) feet apart for required distancing and utilize a required mask.
- Microwaves and vending machines will be accessible.
- Visitors are allowed to bring in currency (no larger bills than a five (\$5) dollar bill). The maximum amount of currency is thirty dollars (\$30) per person

Authorized child-care items:

- One (1) clear baby bottle (no glass).
- One (1) unopened container of baby food.
- One (1) baby spoon.
- One (1) diaper.
- One (1) small container of wipes.
- One (1) clear, transparent bag to store the items in.

- **Camp Visitation is by appointment only.**
- Inmates must submit a visitation request form to their counselor.
- Visitation requests will be honored based on the space availability needed to maintain social distancing.
 - A maximum of two (5) visitors are allowed per inmate.
 - Children of any age count as a visitor.
 - All visitors must wear a plain, non-vented, cloth face mask that covers the mouth and nose at all times.
- Authorized child-care items:
 - One (1) clear baby bottle (no glass).
 - One (1) unopened container of baby food.
 - One (1) baby spoon.
 - One (1) diaper.
 - One (1) small container of wipes.
 - One (1) clear, transparent bag to store the items in.
