Walkaway from FCI Seagoville's Satellite Camp

SEAGOVILLE, TEXAS: On Friday, September 5, 2025, at approximately 3:30 p.m., Ruben Enriquez was discovered missing from the satellite camp adjacent to the Federal Correctional Institution in Seagoville, Texas.

Mr. Enriquez is a 52-year-old Hispanic male with black hair, brown eyes, is 5'9" tall, and weighs approximately 220 pounds. The United States Marshals Service, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, and other law enforcement agencies were notified. An internal investigation was initiated. Anyone with information about this individual should contact the United States Marshals Service at (214) 767-0836.

Mr. Enriquez was sentenced in the Eastern District of Texas to a 210-month sentence for Conspiracy to Possess with the Intent to Distribute 50 Grams or More of Methamphetamine.

The satellite camp at FCI Seagoville is a minimum security facility.
