## **Death at FPC Duluth**

DULUTH, MN: On Monday, September 8, 2025, at approximately 8:30 a.m., Terrance Wayne Buescher was found unresponsive at the Federal Prison Camp (FPC) Duluth in Duluth, Minnesota.

Responding employees initiated life-saving measures. Emergency medical services (EMS) were requested while life-saving efforts continued. Mr. Buescher was subsequently pronounced deceased by EMS personnel.

The Federal Bureau of Investigation was notified.

No employees or other incarcerated individuals were injured and at no time was the public in danger.

Mr. Buescher was a 60-year-old male who was sentenced in the Northern District of Iowa to a 60-month sentence for Attempt and Conspiracy to Distribute a Mixture or Substance Containing a Detectable Amount of Methamphetamine. He had been in custody at FPC Duluth since September 16, 2024.

FPC Duluth is a minimum security facility.
