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Death at USP Coleman II

SUMTERVILLE, FL: On Friday, September 19, 2025, at approximately 7:00 a.m., Austin Ray Sabb-Visga was found unresponsive at the United States Penitentiary (USP) Coleman II, in Sumterville, Florida.

Responding employees initiated life-saving measures. Emergency medical services (EMS) were requested while life-saving measures continued. Mr. Sabb-Visga was transported by EMS to a local hospital. Subsequently, on September 20, 2025, Mr. Sabb-Visga was pronounced deceased by hospital personnel.

The Federal Bureau of Investigation was notified.

No employees or other incarcerated individuals were injured, and at no time was the public in danger.

Mr. Sabb-Visga was a 31-year-old male who was sentenced in the Eastern District of Michigan, to a 600-month sentence for Conspiracy to Sexually Exploit Children and Sexual Exploitation of Children. He had been in custody at USP Coleman II since March 3, 2025.

USP Coleman II, is a high security facility.
