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Death at FDC Miami

MIAMI, FL: On Saturday, November 15, 2025, at approximately 3:40 PM, Anthony Frederic Brillante was found unresponsive at the Federal Detention Center (FDC) Miami in Miami, Florida.

Responding employees initiated life-saving measures. Emergency Medical Services (EMS) were requested while life-saving efforts continued. Mr. Brillante was subsequently pronounced deceased by EMS personnel.

The Federal Bureau of Investigation and the United States Marshall Service were notified.

No employees or other incarcerated individuals were injured and at no time was the public in danger.

Mr. Brillante was a 37-year-old male sentenced in the Southern District of Miami to a 108-month sentence for Stalking and Cyber Harassment. He had been in custody at FDC Miami since September 11, 2025.

FDC Miami is an administrative security facility.
