Death at FCI Greenville

GREENVILLE, IL: On Tuesday, November 18, 2025, at approximately 2:45 p.m., Kenneth Lewis York was found unresponsive at the Federal Correctional Institution (FCI) Greenville in Greenville, Illinois.

Responding employees-initiated life-saving measures. Emergency medical services (EMS) were requested while life-saving efforts continued. Mr. York was transported by EMS to a local hospital and subsequently pronounced deceased by hospital personnel.

The Federal Bureau of Investigation and the United States Marshals Service was notified.

No employees or other incarcerated individuals were injured and at no time was the public in danger.

Mr. York was a 67- year- old male who was sentenced in the Western District of Virginia to a 365-month sentence for Transportation with intent to engage in criminal sexual activity with a minor, Mailing Threatening Communications, and Threatening a Law Enforcement Officer. He had been in custody at FCI Greenville since August 6, 2025.

FCI Greenville is a medium security facility.
