Death at MCFP Springfield

SPRINGFIELD, MO: On Wednesday, December 31, 2025, at approximately 9:05 a.m., Javon R. Williams was found unresponsive at the Medical Center for Federal Prisoners (MCFP) Springfield in Springfield, Missouri.

Responding employees initiated life-saving measures. Emergency medical services (EMS) were requested while life-saving efforts continued. Mr. Williams was subsequently pronounced deceased by EMS personnel.

No employees or other incarcerated individuals were injured, and at no time was the public in danger.

Mr. Williams was a 35-year-old male who was sentenced in the Eastern District of Kentucky to a 120-month sentence for conspiracy to distribute methamphetamine. He had been in custody at MCFP Springfield since November 6, 2024

MCFP Springfield is an administrative security facility.
