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Death at FCI McKean

LEWIS RUN, PA: On Friday, January 9, 2026, at approximately 3:15 p.m., inmate Kevin Montemayor, was found unresponsive at the Federal Correctional Institution (FCI) McKean, in Lewis Run, PA.

Responding employees initiated life-saving measures. Emergency medical services (EMS) were requested while life-saving efforts continued. Mr. Montemayor was transported by EMS to a local hospital and subsequently pronounced deceased by hospital personnel.

The Federal Bureau of Investigation was notified.

No employees or other incarcerated individuals were injured, and at no time was the public in danger.

Mr. Montemayor was a 30-year-old male who was sentenced in the Southern District of Texas to an aggregate 180-month sentence for Possession of Child Pornography and Sexual Exploitation of Children. He had been in custody at FCI McKean since October 3, 2024.

FCI McKean is a medium security facility.
