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Death at FCI Texarkana

TEXARKANA, TX: On Monday, March 2, 2026, at approximately 4:45 p.m., Dixon Kelley III, was found unresponsive at the Federal Correctional Institution (FCI) Texarkana in Texarkana, Texas.

Responding employees initiated life-saving measures. Emergency medical services (EMS) were requested while life-saving efforts continued. Mr. Kelley was subsequently pronounced deceased by EMS personnel.

The Federal Bureau of Investigation and the United States Marshals Service were notified.

No employees or other incarcerated individuals were injured and at no time was the public in danger.

Mr. Kelley was a 52-year-old male who was sentenced in the Eastern District of Texas to a 177-month sentence for Bank Robbery by Force or Violence. He had been in custody at FCI Texarkana since December 19, 2017.

FCI Texarkana is a Low Security Level facility.
