Walkaway from FCI Mendota's Satellite Camp


MENDOTA, CA: On Sunday, March 22, 2026, at approximately 9:00 p.m., Edgar Enriquez was discovered missing from the satellite camp adjacent to the Federal Correctional Institution (FCI) Mendota in Mendota, California.

Mr. Enriquez is a 38-year-old White Hispanic male with black hair, brown eyes, is 5'6" tall, and weighs approximately 174 pounds. The United States Marshals Service, Federal Bureau of Investigation, and other law enforcement agencies were notified. An internal investigation was initiated. Anyone with information about this individual should contact the United States Marshals Service at (559) 442-2800.

Mr. Enriquez was sentenced in the Southern District of California to an aggregate 109-month sentence for Importation of Cocaine, Conspiracy to Distribute Heroin, Conspiracy to Distribute Methamphetamine, Possession with Intent to Distribute Methamphetamine, and Aiding and Abetting.

The satellite camp at FCI Mendota is a minimum security facility.
