Death at FCI Milan

MILAN, MI: On Tuesday, April 14, 2026, at approximately 7:00 p.m., Jacob Medina was found unresponsive at the Federal Correctional Institution (FCI) Milan in Milan, Michigan.

Responding employees initiated life-saving measures. Emergency medical services (EMS) were requested while life-saving efforts continued. Mr. Medina was subsequently pronounced deceased by medical personnel.

The Federal Bureau of Investigation was notified. No employees or other incarcerated individuals were injured and at no time was the public in danger.

Mr. Medina was a 41-year-old male who was sentenced in the Western District of Wisconsin to a 150-month sentence for Possession of Child Pornography, Class C Felony. He had been in custody at FCI Milan since November 24, 2025.

FCI Milan is a low security facility.
