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Death at MCC San Diego

SAN DIEGO, CA: On Sunday, May 17, 2026, at approximately 1:15 p.m., Steven Lee Davis was found unresponsive following a perceived altercation at the Metropolitan Correctional Center (MCC) San Diego, in San Diego, California.

Responding employees initiated life-saving measures. Emergency medical services (EMS) were requested while life-saving efforts continued. Mr. Davis was subsequently pronounced deceased by EMS personnel.

The Federal Bureau of Investigation and the United States Marshals Service were notified.

No employees or other incarcerated individuals were injured, and at no time was the public in danger.

Mr. Davis was a 60-year-old male who was a pretrial inmate at MCC San Diego after being indicted for Bank Robbery. He had been in custody at MCC San Diego since March 30, 2026.

MCC San Diego is an administrative security facility.
