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Death at USP Terre Haute

TERRE HAUTE, IN: On Monday, June 1, 2026, at approximately 3:40 p.m., Rodney Belvado was found unresponsive at the United States Penitentiary (USP) Terre Haute, in Terre Haute, Indiana.

Responding employees initiated life-saving measures. Emergency medical services (EMS) were requested while life-saving efforts continued. Mr. Belvado was subsequently pronounced deceased by EMS personnel.

The Federal Bureau of Investigation was notified.

No employees or other incarcerated individuals were injured, and at no time was the public in danger.

Mr. Belvado was a 41-year-old male who was sentenced in the District of Arizona to a Life sentence for First Degree Murder. He had been in custody at USP Terre Haute since September 26, 2017.

USP Terre Haute is a high-security facility.
