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Death at FCI Edgefield

EDGEFIELD, SC: On Friday, June 26, 2026, at approximately 11:40 a.m., Harold Nolan was found unresponsive at the Federal Correctional Institution (FCI) Edgefield in Edgefield, South Carolina.

Responding employees initiated life-saving measures. Emergency medical services (EMS) were requested while life-saving efforts continued.

Mr. Nolan was transported by EMS to a local hospital and subsequently pronounced deceased by hospital personnel.

The Federal Bureau of Investigation was notified.

No employees or other incarcerated individuals were injured, and at no time was the public in danger.

Mr. Nolan was a 45-year-old male who was sentenced in the Eastern District of Kentucky to a 180-month sentence for Distribution of Visual Depiction of Minor Engaging in Sexual Conduct. He had been in custody at FCI Edgefield since March 25, 2026.

FCI Edgefield is a medium security facility.
