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Death at USP Florence

FLORENCE, CO: On Monday, August 24, 2026, at approximately 12:10 p.m., George Hall was found unresponsive at the United States Penitentiary (USP) in Florence, Colorado

Responding employees initiated life-saving measures. Emergency medical services (EMS) were requested while life-saving efforts continued. Mr. Hall was subsequently pronounced deceased by EMS personnel.

The Federal Bureau of Investigation was notified.

No employees or other incarcerated individuals were injured, and at no time was the public in danger.

Mr. Hall was a 55-year-old male who was sentenced in the Southern District of Florida to a 120-month sentence with 3 years' supervised release for assault with a dangerous weapon with intent to do bodily harm on another inmate. He had been in custody at the United States Penitentiary, Florence, since August 6, 2026.

USP Florence is a high security facility.
