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Walkaway from USP Tucson's Satellite Camp

TUCSON, AZ: On Wednesday, September 2, 2026, at approximately 8:10 a.m., James Cangro was discovered missing from the satellite camp adjacent to the United States Penitentiary (USP) Tucson in Tucson, Arizona.

Mr. Cangro is a 46-year-old White male with brown hair, brown eyes, is 5'11" tall, and weighs approximately 200 pounds. The United States Marshals Service, the Federal of Bureau of Investigation, and other law enforcement agencies were notified. An internal investigation was initiated. Mr. Cangro was sentenced in the District of New Mexico to a 132-month sentence for violent felon in possession of a firearm and ammunition, violent felon in possession of body armor, possession of a firearm not registered in the national firearms registration and transfer record, possession with intent to distribute fentanyl, and possession with intent to distribute 50 grams and more of a mixture and substance containing methamphetamine.

The satellite camp at USP Tucson is a minimum security facility.
