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Furlough Escape from FCI Miami

MIAMI, FL: On Friday, September 11, 2026, at approximately 9:00 p.m., Sherman Kemp was discovered missing following a failure to report to the adjacent satellite camp at Federal Correctional Institution (FCI) Jesup in Jesup, Georgia, after a furlough transfer from the Federal Correctional Institution (FCI) Miami in Miami, Florida.

Mr. Kemp is a 47-year-old Black male with black hair and brown eyes. He is 5'7" tall and weighs approximately 185 pounds. The United States Marshals Service, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, and other law enforcement agencies were notified. An internal investigation was initiated. Mr. Kemp was sentenced in the District of Maryland and the Eastern District of Pennsylvania to an aggregate 324-month sentence for Conspiracy to Distribute Over Five Kilograms of Cocaine, Possession of a Firearm in Furtherance of a Drug Trafficking Crime, Felon in Possession of a Firearm, and Possession with Intent to Distribute Over 500 Grams of Cocaine, Conspiracy to Distribute and Possess with Intent to Distribute Heroin.

FCI Miami is a low security facility.
