

**NARA - WAIVER OF APPEARANCE IN COURT**

If for any reason the aforementioned Judge or any other Judge in his stead should feel it is incumbent upon himself to enter any order in this matter, such as a prison term, fine, suspended sentence or probation, or any combination thereof, then I reserve my right to be present in Court at that time.
