## Update on the Scheduled Execution of – William Emmett Lecroy Jr.

Terre Haute, Indiana: The Court Order to execute Mr. William Lecroy has been fulfilled.

Pursuant to the sentence of the United States Court for the Northern District of Georgia, William Lecroy has been executed by lethal injection.

He was pronounced dead at 9:06 p.m. Eastern Daylight Time by the Vigo County Coroner.

William Emmett Lecroy, Jr., 50, robbed, sexually assaulted, and stabbed a 30-year-old woman to death in Georgia. On March 10, 2004, a jury in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Georgia found Lecroy guilty of the following offense: With the Intent to Cause Death and Serious Bodily Harm, did take a Ford Explorer Motor Vehicle that has been Transported, Shipped, and Received in Interstate Commerce from the Person and Presence of Joann Lee Tielser by Force and Violence Resulting in her Death, to which he was sentenced to death.

USP Terre Haute is a High security facility with approximately 1300 male inmates.
