Offense Information

Offense Date: June 27, 2002

Offense Description: Inmate Higgs kidnapped and murdered three women. Higgs and two friends drove the women to a secluded area in the Patuxent National Wildlife Refuge, and ordered the women out of the vehicle. Higgs gave a gun to each of the friends, and the women were subsequently shot to death. On October 11, 2000, a jury in the U.S. District Court for the District of Maryland found Higgs guilty of multiple offenses, three counts of first degree premeditated murder, three counts of kidnapping resulting in death, and unanimously recommended the death sentence.
