Offense Date: October 28, 2001

Offense Description: Lezmond Charles Mitchell stabbed to death a 63-year-old grandmother and forced her nine-year-old granddaughter to sit beside the lifeless body during a 30-to-40-mile drive. Mitchell then slit the girl's throat twice, crushed her head with 20-pound rocks, and then severed and buried both victims' heads and hands. On May 8, 2003, a jury in the U.S. District Court for the District of Arizona found Mitchell guilty of numerous offenses, including first degree murder, felony murder, and carjacking resulting in murder; he was sentenced to death. Mitchell's execution is scheduled to occur on August 26, 2020.
