On June 13, 2000, a jury in the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Texas found inmate Vialva guilty of the following offenses: Carjacking; First Degree Murder on a Government Reservation, Aiding and Abetting (two counts) to which he was sentenced to Death. Inmate Vialva was also convicted by the jury for Conspiracy to Commit Murder, for which he was sentenced to Life without the possibility of release.
