Offense Date: June 20, 1999

Offense Description: Inmate Bernard murdered an Iowa couple in Fort Hood, Texas. Bernard carjacked a vehicle, shot the two occupants, and then burned them inside the vehicle. On June 13, 2000, a jury in the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Texas found Bernard guilty of, among other offenses, two counts of First Degree Murder within the special maritime and territorial jurisdiction of the United States, and unanimously recommended a death sentence. Inmate Bernard was also convicted by the jury for Carjacking; Conspiracy to Commit Murder, for which he was sentenced to Life without the possibility of release.
